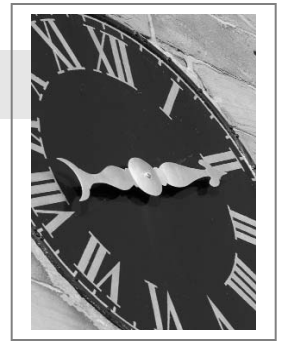

## Thank you for enquiring about Gift Aid

People often choose to support many good causes but their resources can only stretch so far. The need to be able to support the work of the Church is as strong as ever and in this Parish people continue to give very generously to the Church, both towards its resources and in support of the activities which St Nicholas' Church is able to undertake.

There is, however, something which most of us can do to make sure that our contributions provide maximum benefit, and without it costing anyone a penny more. To make sure that whatever donation we chooses to make allows the Church to receive the maximum financial advantage, any contributions made under the Gift Aid Scheme will automatically increase your contribution by a very important 28% - that's £280 extra for every £1000 we receive!

Under the Gift Aid Scheme the Government's Revenue and Customs (HMRC) allows St Nicholas' Church to benefit by 28p for every £1 donated by a UK taxpayer - provided the donation is made under the Gift Aid rules, which most of us can use.

### 1. Contribution by Standing Order

Many people make regular contributions through their bank account by setting up a monthly, quarterly or annual standing order. The facility is straightforward to set up, just a couple of simple forms to complete.

### 2. Envelope Scheme Contributions

Special envelopes are provided for people to make regular contributions by cash or by cheque. You simply place your money in an envelope that carries your unique Gift Aid number and whatever you choose to give automatically qualifies for the extra 28% from the Government.

### 3. Yellow Gift Aid Envelopes

These can be found at the back of Church and are suitable for single donations or for any ad hoc contributions you might wish to make. The reverse of the envelope includes a Gift Aid Declaration. Any contributions made using this special envelope allows the Church to benefit.

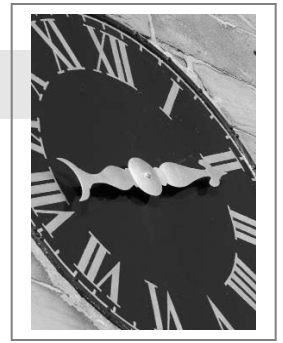
Also, if you are a higher rate tax payer you can benefit from tax relief on the value of your donations under Gift Aid based on the difference between the higher rate and the basic rate.

Many parishioners choose to make contributions by both standing order and through the envelope scheme, so please feel free to give in any way that suits your personal circumstances. The important element is to ensure that the Church benefits from the extra 28p from every £1.

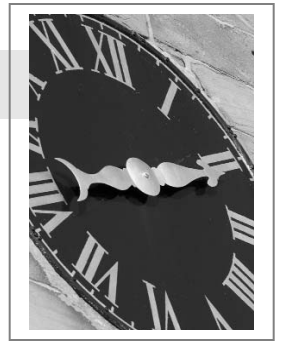

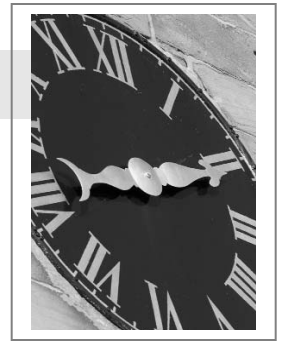

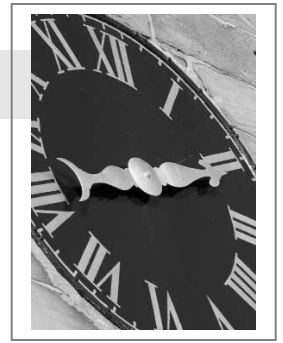
